

NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PUBLIC VACATION A PORTION OF CITY OF LASALLE ALLEY

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby provided of a public hearing that will take place on June 18, 2013 as part of the City of LaSalle regular City Council Meeting taking place in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 745 Second Street, LaSalle, Illinois, concerning the potential vacation by the City of LaSalle and related matters of a portion of the City of LaSalle streets and/or alleys commonly described as a portion of the alley between 8th Street and 9th Street within the City of LaSalle between LaHarpe Street and Sterling Street within the City of LaSalle, which portion of said alley under consideration for potential vacation is more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Alley in Block 27 in the Original Town, now City of LaSalle, LaSalle County, Illinois described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Lot 6 in said Block 27; thence Northerly along the East Line of said Lot 6 to the Northeast Corner of said Lot 6; thence Easterly along the South Line of Lots 4, 3 and 2 to the Northwest Corner of Lot 7 in said Block 27; thence Southerly along the West Line of said Lot 7 to the Southwest Corner of said Lot 7; thence Easterly along the South Line of said Lot 7 to the Southeast Corner of said Lot 7; thence Southerly along the East Line of said Block 27 to the Northeast Corner of Lot 8 in Block 27; thence Westerly along the North Line of said Lot 8 to the Northwest Corner of said Lot 8; thence Southerly along the West Line of said Lot 8 to the Southwest Corner of said Lot 8; thence Westerly 40 feet along the North Line of Lots 13 and 12 in said Block 27; thence Northerly parallel with the West Line of said Lot 8 to an Easterly extension of the South Line of Lot 6 in Block 27; thence Westerly 40 feet along said Easterly extension to the Point of Beginning, containing 0.144 acres more or less.

That following the public hearing and at the same regular City Council meeting for the City of LaSalle and/or thereafter, the City Council of the City of LaSalle may consider an Ordinance in connection with the vacation of all and/or part of said right-of-way; the vacation of such right-of-way may include such provisions and such reservations as the City of LaSalle City Council deems appropriate in the circumstances including, but not being limited to, the reservation in the City of LaSalle of all rights and an easement in reference to access to maintenance, construction, repair and use of and by the City of the existing utilities on the vacated premises; that said vacation shall be further subject to such other terms, covenants, provisions, conditions, and/or contingencies as the City Council of the City of LaSalle may deem appropriate in the circumstances.

That said public hearing will take place in accord with appropriate law, and all parties will be provided an opportunity to be heard in connection with said matters.
