NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PUBLIC VACATION
A Portion of City of La Salle Alley

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby provided of a public hearing that will take place on Tuesday, October 7, 2014 as part of the City of LaSalle regular City Council Meeting taking place in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 745 Second Street, LaSalle, Illinois, concerning the potential vacation by the City of LaSalle and related matters of a portion of the City of LaSalle streets and/or alleys commonly described as part of the public alley commonly known as the south 32 feet of the diamond portion of the alley between Chartres Street and Peru Street, east and west, and between Seventh Street and Sixth Street, north and south, more particularly described as follows:

Part of the alley in Brown's Subdivision of Block 43 in the Original Town, now City of LaSalle, in the County of LaSalle and State of Illinois, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Lot 9 in Brown's Subdivision of Block 43 in the Original Town of LaSalle, thence Easterly 80 feet in said Brown's Subdivision along an extension of the North Line of said Lot 9 to the Northwest Corner of Lot 8 in said Brown's Subdivision; thence Southerly 32 feet along the West Line of said Lots 8 to the Southwest Corner of said Lot 8; thence Westerly 10 feet along the North Line of Lot 13 in said Brown's Subdivision to the Northwest Corner of said Lot 13; thence continuing Westerly 60 feet along the North Line of Lot 12 in said Brown's Subdivision to the Northwest Corner of said Lot 12; thence continuing Westerly 10 feet along the North Line of Lot 11 in said Brown's Subdivision to the Southeast Corner of said Lot 9; thence Northerly 32 feet along the East Line of said Lot 9 to the Point of Beginning, containing 0.059 acres, more or less.

That following the public hearing and at the same regular City Council meeting for the City of La Salle and/or thereafter, the City Council of the City of La Salle may consider an ordinance in connection with the vacation of all and/or part of said right-a-way; the vacation of such right-a-way may include such provisions and such reservations as the City of La Salle City Council deems appropriate in the circumstances including, but not limited to , the reservation in the City of La Salle of all rights and an easement in reference to access to maintenance, construction, repair and use of and by the City of the existing utilities on the vacated premises, that said vacation shall be further subject to such other terms, covenants, provision, conditions and/or contingencies as the City Council of the City of La Salle may deem appropriate in the circumstances. That said public hearing will take place in accord with appropriate law and all parties will be provided an opportunity to be heard in connection with said matters.
