

LaSalle Police Department Trespass Agreement

This agreement, made and executed this _____ day of _____, 20____, by _____ of _____ and by Officer _____ # _____, as agent of the City of LaSalle, Illinois, a municipal corporation, provides as follows:

Section 1 - Purpose and Agreement

It is recognized that in certain situations the use of LaSalle Police Officers to control certain activities on private property located within the City may be desirable and necessary in order to preserve health, safety, and welfare of the public.

Section 2 - Power and Authority

a. I, _____ as _____ do hereby authorize and grant the City of LaSalle, as my agent, the power to control persons who enter and remain upon all property located at:

_____ LaSalle, Illinois.

b. The City of LaSalle shall have the power to arrest trespassers.

c. I, _____ as _____, hereby agree that I will cooperate with the City in any criminal prosecutions that may arise from the City exercising the authority granted by this agreement.

Section 3 - Effective Date of Agreement

a. This agreement shall be in full effect and legally binding upon signature by both parties.

b. The Chief of Police or designee will retain the original signed agreement and will be responsible for circulating such agreement for purposes of signature and record.

Section 4 - Termination of Agreement

a. This agreement is terminable by either party upon 24 hours notice, in writing, to the other party.

b. Upon sale or transfer of the property, it is the responsibility of the owner/manager to notify the LaSalle police of such change, in writing.

Section 5 - Trespass Banning Process

a. If the property owner/manager finds cause and chooses to ban a subject from their property the procedure is as follows:

- (1) The property owner/manager or police officer, as agent, shall serve notice, in writing, to the subject that they are banned from the property
- (2) A copy of this banned notice shall be sent the Police Department's Telecommunications supervisor for computer entry. The original copy shall be stamped and sent to the Chief of Police or designee for filing.
- (3) It is the responsibility of the owner/manager to notify all of their tenants of subjects that are banned from their property.
- (4) When a property owner/manager decides to no longer ban an individual the owner/manager shall notify The LaSalle Police of the change of status.

Section 6 - Signs Posted

The property owner shall post in a prominent location **NO TRESPASSING** signs on the property(s) covered by this agreement. The property owner is responsible to maintain the signs.
