INVITATION FOR BIDS

The City of La Salle will receive sealed bids for the Long Term Control Plan, Hegeler Park Storm Sewer Separation – 2019 until 10:00 AM., on the 7th day of February, 2019, at the office of the City Clerk, 745 2nd Street, La Salle, Illinois 61301 at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed work is officially known as “Long Term Control Plan, Hegeler Park Storm Sewer Separation – 2019”, and further described as sanitary and storm sewer installation from Hegeler Park to Sterling Street. Work shall include, but not limited to the installation of 1544 feet of 48” sanitary sewer, 370 feet of sanitary sewer varying in size from 10” to 30”, 265 feet of storm sewer varying in size from 12” to 54”, 22 manholes varying from 4’ diameter to 9’ diameter, 6 inlets, 400 tons of hot-mix asphalt, concrete driveway replacement, concrete sidewalk replacement, surface restoration, including all other work as further described in the plans and specifications for said work prepared by the City of LaSalle.

Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications, are on file at the office of the City Engineer, 745 2nd Street, La Salle, Illinois 61301. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained at no cost.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of the City of La Salle or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

The successful bidder for the construction of the improvements will be required to enter into a bond equal to 100% of the amount of the bid with sureties to be approved by the Mayor and City Council, when entering into the contract for construction of the improvements, which shall be conditioned upon the proper and faithful performance by the contractor of the work specified in accordance with the plans and specifications thereof.

The City of La Salle reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City of La Salle for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
