**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The City of La Salle will hold a public hearing on July 29, at 6:30pm, at La Salle City Hall Council Chambers at 745 Second St., La Salle IL, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Katherine Koyak at 745 Second St, La Salle IL 61301 or 815-223-3755 Ext. 5021 no later than Thursday, July 25, 2019. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about August 29, 2019, The City of La Salle intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: separate storm sewer flows from the sanitary/combined sewer system. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$500,000. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$297,575. The City of La Salle also proposes to expend \$279,220 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Sewer Reserve Fund.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of July 18, 2019 at City Hall, 745 Second St. La Salle, IL between the hours of 8am-4pm. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Carrie Brown, City Clerk no later than 2pm on Monday, July 29, 2019 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by City of La Salle and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons.
