

**Meeting of the Streets, Alleys and Traffic Committee of the City of La Salle**

A quorum was present.

In regard to the request for a "Cross Traffic Does Not Stop" sign added to the stop sign located on Campbell Avenue at Garfield Avenue, Mr. Jeff Struna, resident of 1850 Campbell Avenue explained that traffic from Garfield to Campbell is his main concern. He stated that due to cars being parked on the north side of Garfield, many times drivers must enter the left lane to get around the cars. Drivers heading north on Campbell who are then turning east onto Garfield, do not always yield to the cars that may be utilizing the left lane. He stated that he has had to back up on more than on occasion. His suggestion is to add the "Cross Traffic Does Not Stop" sign to warn drivers that there may be on-coming cars. Mr. Struna stated that he is not aware of any accidents and personally tries to avoid the area.

Chairman Bacidore asked for a vote. Alderman Bacidore, Ptak, Reynolds, Lavieri, Jeppson, Herndon vote in favor of recommending that the sign is added to the Stop Sign. Alderman Crane voted Nay because he had concerns about the legality of adding a sign to a sign.
