Chairman Jim Bacidore opened the meeting to discuss a request for a stop sign at Canal and Crosat streets for east and westbound traffic. Chairman Bacidore explained the complaint was about traffic going over the speed limit, specifically during the morning and afternoon rush hour when Illinois Cement workers arrive and depart the site. Alderman John Lavieri said he used to live there for 11 years and never noticed an issue, he last lived there in 2000. Alderman Jerry Reynolds said he visited the site and drivers were traveling at speeds over the speed limit. He also noted kids play in the area.
