BILLS

Alderman Jeppson asked why the city was buying so much road salt. Director Watson stated that those bills were old and dated from February. This is all the salt they bought for the year. Watson stated that they did not use as much as last year.

Alderman Lavieri asked about a bill. Finance Director clarified that it was for Christmas displays at the Celebration of Lights.

Chairman Ptak began this discussion and potential recommendation regarding a request from Lucas Weiden of WL Ventures for a Redevelopment Incentive Program grant totaling \$12,500 for premises located at 849 First St. Chairman Ptak stated right away that he would need two bids. The city only received the one. Bedei notified Weiden about getting two bids. Weiden hired this contractor for interior work, so he wanted to use him again. The committee agreed that he would still need another bid for them to approve for consideration of the grant.

Finance Director Duncan mentioned that the committee should meet soon to discuss the Annual Budget.

There were no more questions or comments from the public.
