Deputy Clerk Brent Bader reminded all to speak clearly into the mics for the video and audio recordings.

Moved by Alderman Reynolds and seconded by Alderman Herndon to approve the minutes from August 19, 2024.

Voice vote, all ayes. Motion carried.

Alderman Herndon and Chairman Ptak both agreed that the city made the right decision to go with the electric and utility for the eight-month period and that nine other communities were involved with this group rate.

Chairman Ptak asked for an update on Route 6 progress, even though it is not necessarily Finance related. City Engineer Brian Brown stated that he does not have accurate report from either contractor groups on what is to be done. He did indicate good progress on the curb and gutter work. Engineer Brown stated that there is a goal of completing pavement markings before the year's end. They do plan on milling everything at once when they have the milling machine in town when the Richard Hallett and Eighth Street project begins.

The discrepancy at Crosat and Fifth was clarified, attributing it to a sewer inlet that does meet current standards.
