

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

OF THE LA SALLE CITY COUNCIL

October 14, 2024

A regular meeting of the La Salle City Council of La Salle, Illinois was held, Monday, October 14, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. with Mayor Jeff Grove with proper notices being duly and continuously posted.

The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Deputy Clerk Brent Bader reminded all to speak into microphones clearly for audio and video recordings.

A quorum was present.

Dawn Hicks expressed concerns about the air quality and the air monitor readings, highlighting high pollution readings at various times in the area. She questioned the source of the pollution and emphasized the need for immediate action rather than waiting for more severe readings. Hicks also requested information on who to contact to get veterans acknowledged and how to go about getting the banners for the veterans.

Dena Hicks spoke in regard to her concerns with the air quality concerns also. She provided detailed information on the health risks associated with different air quality readings, emphasizing the need for public awareness and action.

BIDS

Bids for 2024 water system improvements, new well drilling, and the existing water treatment plant project were discussed. Alderman Thompson was very concerned that one bid was substantially lower than the other two. City Engineer Brian Brown mentioned that there is a state statute if there is an unemployment rate of greater than 5% over two months, then the city would have to use 90% Illinois employees. Municipal Well and Pump uses both Illinois and Iowa. Brown does not believe the city to be in that window of unemployment. Brown believes that the other two bidders were pushing for that and were bidding accordingly. He believed the project to cost between \$2.5 million and \$3 million. He stated that this award is contingent upon everything getting verified. Engineer Brown believed that there was a 180-day completion goal after the bid award.

This project was discussed in a prior meeting, and it was mentioned to go to a 24-hr deep well for this project. It was still expected to have the site screening for lighting and also a sound barrier created to minimize the impacts for the neighbors as much as they possibly could. This project location is on the south side of the water treatment plant.

Moved by Alderman Thompson and seconded by Alderman Reynolds to accept the bid price of \$2,679,016.00 from Municipal Well and Pump for 2024 water system improvements, new well drilling (a.k.a. Deep Well) and the existing Water Treatment Plant project. These are subject to all contingencies discussed and subject to entering into a contract with the city.

The owner indicated that he had discussed with both east and west neighbors and he indicated that he would resolve any issues with the landscaping with the one property owner. He also mentioned that the city will have a control burn next Tuesday to make room for other yard waste.

The city's Halloween event will be Saturday, October 26th downtown LaSalle, with 10:45 am line up for costume contest with business trick or treating after.

Deputy Clerk Brent Bader mentioned that there will be a community garden initiative led by Renee Kim with the availability of a city plot near the fire department. She is looking for volunteers to assist with this initiative.

Deputy Clerk Bader addressed the issue of mattresses or larger item disposal, reminding residents to call LRS for large item pickup. The LRS phone number to call to schedule large item pick ups is 309-586-4410.

Mayor Grove mentioned property damage done to the planter and flagpole at the island at 1st and LaHarpe. He mentioned that the city will make one more attempt to better the visibility. If this damage does happen to this area again, then it was discussed to possibly remove the island.
