Separate them out so if the call is for a Custody Issue-then it just says Custody Issue in the incident code in the CAD.

d. Trespass files-List all lifetime trespasses under one file. If a trespass has an expiration date, then enter those separately with the expiration date so it will automatically come off upon expiration date. Dispatch needs to know if there is an expiration date so the trespass is entered correctly.

e. TC's have been doing ride-a-longs with officers, mainly Peru. This has been a good experience for the TC's and the officers.

f. IVRD used the new command bus for Oglesby's large training/drill.

i. IVRD would like to participate in any trainings or drills.

g. Is there any way to get the 911 texting data from the phone system integrated into the CAD. Currently for alarms that come in via text or 911's that come in as a text, we have to reenter the information into the CAD. The system will not enable copy and paste or transfer the information.

h. CAD shared data

i. Need for more Race options in the CAD. Currently our options are: American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, Unknown or White. Hispanic and Puerto Rican are currently not an option.

j. Multiple towns can create a case report off the same CAD.

CESSA is integrating mobile responses with Police and EMS calls.

a. There was a discussion about Callers in Crisis to send the ambulance and have the police stage in case they are needed. Chief Raymond asked about the 1st responder requirements.
